Virus and Spyware Alerts...

Backdoor.Ginwui.F is a Trojan horse that opens a back door and uses rootkit techniques to hide its presence. The Trojan arrives as part of a malicious Microsoft PowerPoint document. This document is a copy of Trojan.PPDropper. Spyware.SysDetective is a spyware program that gathers sensitive information from the computer and sends it to a remote user. The program can then perform the following actions: Take screenshots, Record keystrokes, Monitor visited Web sites, Send this information to remote users by email or FTP, Close any applications or Web sites that contain certain keywords, Send an email to remote users when certain keywords are entered on the keyboard and Prevent access to certain Web sites.
